Terms and Conditions for the Independent Published Materials by DXN Members in Mexico

1. All DXN members are not allowed to publish deliver or send printed materials (including but not limited flyers, posters, newsletters, magazines etc) or any other materials published in any other form of media (hereinafter referred to as "independent published materials") which relates to DXN without obtaining prior written consent from DXN.
2. DXN only recognizes official publications published by DXN Mexico Main Office, DXN Head Quarters in Malaysia and other DXN branches in the overseas.
3. The publication of any independent published materials by DXN members is a conditional privilege and shall not be considered as a matter of right or entitlement to any DXN member. DXN reserves its absolute and unrestricted right, at its sole discretion, any point of time to cancel, annul, discontinue or disallow, at any time, the publication, delivery of sending any independent published materials by DXN members without assigning any reasons hereto.
4. Should any DXN member intend to publish, deliver or send independent published materials on anything related to DXN on his / her own, or by any third parties assigned to that effect, he / she must submit the draft contents of the independent published materials to the DXN management previous approval. Publication of independent published materials shall commence by any DXN Member, only after a formal written consent is issued from DXN as stated herein. The finalized and printed version of any independent published material must not deviate from the approved version by DXN. A copy of all finalized and printed version of the authorized independent published materials MUST be submitted to the Publication Department of DXN Mexico no later than 1 week from the date of its publication delivery and sending.
5. In the event that any DXN member publishes any independent published materials, as a whole or any portion of which is untrue or inaccurate, or without written consent from DXN, or in the event that DXN has reasonable grounds to suspect that such information is untrue, inaccurate or not in accordance with the Terms and Conditions contained herein or in general with any regulation from DXN, DXN has the absolute right to take necessary remedies or disciplinary action including but not limited to suspension or termination of the distributorship, among others.
